Babies Room News




This term in Baby Room, we have been looking at our favourite story books: The Gruffalo, Monkey Puzzle and Room on the broom. The babies have enjoyed using a range of different materials, these include: painting, sticking, mark making with paint dabbers and crayons to make their pieces of art work for our display.



The babies have been busy matching animals to their young, making and exploring Gruffalo crumble, making marks in flour and searching in porridge oats to find the characters from Room on the Broom. The Dragon was a popular choice! During group time, the babies have been listening to their favourite stories in different ways, including: adults reading the books or using audio books. We have celebrated Earth day and St. Georges Day this term by: Creating shields, using paint and using a range of different stamps to create our very own earth.





We have celebrated and said Happy Birthday to Jacob and Ralph, who turned 3, and Teddy who turned 2!




Pre-School News
